- Test and implement training material in the UK, Greece, Italy, Romania and Belgium and use the comparative learning for informing national and EU-wide practices and policies.

IO3: C2E: Making it happen for Europe (11/19-01/20)

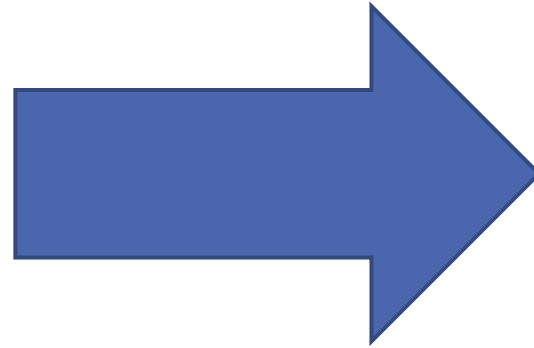
2 e-courses addressed to

The e-courses will reach:

- over 100 young carers (at least 20 per partner) and
- over 100 professionals (at least 20 per partner).

- Innovative and interactive

- Evaluation questionnaires
- Demographics of beneficiaries.



IO3 Report

- will build on the materials developed in IO1 to develop a range of interactive modules and self-assessment tools for trainees that can be delivered online without the intervention of a professional trainer.
- will develop course materials in indexed forms

Anziani

- will lead on the HTML design of the courses (broken down into two types: (1) for young carers (2) for professionals)
- design the e-platform

Habilitas

- will ensure that the evaluation of the online course and its implementation is done as per the workplan and timeline.
- Will take responsibility for producing the report that will feature in the project's IO3 capturing the learning from the implementation of the online course in all participating countries.

IARS

- will take the responsibility for accrediting the online material with CPD status as a provider of Continuing Professional Development.
